James says:

In May 2019 Becky, Bethan, Katie and Marika. will be visiting as part of their 8 week church tour. Here is an excerpt from their latest blog:

In January, we had the amazing opportunity of getting to spend two weeks in Cusco, working in a school and spending our team holiday there. We went on multiple tours seeing the Sacred Valley and Sacquayswaman (an ancient Incan settlement) amongst others, whilst learning lots about the Incas and being horrified by the fact they used to sacrifice children! The best tour by far was Machu Picchu, which was even more stunning than it looks in the photos

and rendered us all slightly speechless which, if you know us as a team, is not a common occurrence! We spent four hours in awe of it and all agreed that it is an amazing example of God's wonderful creation!

We spent the other half of it working in a school that the local church had set up. We had the pleasure of working with Becky, who was an Action Teamer on Team Peru in 2015-16 and has now returned to do her year abroad here it was so refreshing to spend time with an English person who knows exactly what this experience is like (thank you Becky!). We helped in some of her classes, looked after some of the younger kids and also taught some of our own English classes, which involved parachute fruit salads and even some ceilidh dancing! It was so lovely to see beyond the touristy centre of Cusco and get to know some of the local people, seeing what God is doing through their work and getting to help a little.

We live in an age of constant and rapid change, what does this mean for our faith? Join us at ECG 2019 to discover just what is our 'Solid Ground'.



Bridlington Christian Bookshop and Charity-Plus shop

Currently we are looking for a new Charity-Plus shop manager in Bridlington.

Jacob's Well Appeal opened its Bridlington **charity plus shop** in 2015 when it took over the Bethany Christian bookshop. More than a normal Christian book shop, a charity shop or coffee bar, our **Charity-Plus Shops** combine elements from all three to create a community hub where dozens of people with no church connections come into contact with God's love every day.

You would be responsible for the day to day running and management of Jacob's Well Charity-Plus shop.

Jacob's Well Charity-Plus shop is a centre that is explicitly Christian, which is run in partnership with local churches. It is a requirement that the shop manager is an active Christian believer who is in regular attendance at and in good relationship with a local church.

Hours & Salary

You are contracted to work for 30 hours per week, 5 days from 10am – 4pm, which includes working on a Saturday. All Jacob's Well Appeal staff are paid the same rate of pay, based on the Real Living Wage, currently £9 per hour.
