
World Day of Prayer Friday 6th March

Did you know...in 1771 when Ebenezer Baptist Church was founded...

George III (George William Frederick) was King of Great Britain and King of Ireland.

On July 12th the first round the world voyage of HMS *Endeavour* ended as it returned to England after almost three years. It was a combined Royal Navy and Royal Society expedition to the south Pacific Ocean from 1768 to 1771. The aims of this expedition were to observe the 1769 transit of Venus across the Sun and to seek evidence of the *Terra Australis Incognita* or "unknown southern land".

The voyage was commissioned by King George III and its commander was Lieutenant James Cook, a junior naval officer with good skills in cartography and mathematics....a Yorkshire lad!!
